1 Penang – Transit City (MOB)

Assemble at Penang airport for your flight to **Munich**.

**Overnight Onboard.

2 Transit City – Munich (Germany) – Salzburg (Austria) (MOB/D)

Upon arrival, tour proceed to Salzburg for city orientation tour include **Salzburg Old Town**.

** Overnight at Salzburg

3 Salzburg (Austria) – Hallstatt – Vienna (BLD)

After breakfast, tour departs to **Vienna** via **Hallstatt** for brief orientation around **Hallstatt Village**. Arrive Vienna, proceed to **Kartner Strasse** for shopping.

**Overnight at Vienna

4 Vienna – Budapest (BLD)

After breakfast, city orientation tour to **Schonbrunn Palace**, **Viennese City Park** and **The Vienna State Opera**. Next, proceed **Budapest**.

**Overnight at Budapest

5 Budapest (Hungary) (BLD)

Today, orientation tour includes **Budapest Fishermen's Bastion** and **Heroes's Square**. Tonight enjoy **Traditional Dance and dinner**.

**Heroes' Square – is one of the major squares of Budapest, Hungary, rich with historic and political connotations.

**Overnight at Budapest

6 Budapest – Banská Bystrica (Slovakia) – Krakow (Poland) (BLD)

Today, tour departs to **Krakow** via **Banská Bystrica** for a brief visit.

**Banská Bystrica – A Hungarian royal town in 1255 and a historical city with an easy access to the surrounding mountains, is a popular winter and summer tourist destination.

**Overnight at Krakow

7 Krakow (BLD)

Explore the 13th century salt mine – **Wieliczka Salt Mine** with visit the **St Kinga**. Next, back to Krakow city orientation tour include, **Krakow Old Town**, **St Mary Basilica** and **St. Florian's Gate**.

**Wieliczka Salt Mine – Being worked for 900 years. It used to be one of the world's biggest and most profitable industrial establishments when common salt was commercially a medieval equivalent of today's oil.

**St. Florian's Gate – located in Krakow, Poland, is a famous Polish Gothic tower built in the early 14th century using red granite as part of the fortifications of the Old Town of Krakow.

**Overnight at Krakow

8 Krawkow– Prague (CzechRep) (BLD)

After breakfast, proceed to Capital of **CzechRep – Prague**.

**Overnight at Prague

9 Prague (Czech Rep) (BLD)

Orientation today includes **Prague Castle**, **Cathedral of St Vitus** and **Old Town Square**. Next enjoy **Vltava Cruise**.

**Old Town Square – Often bursting at the seams with tourists, the old town square features various architectural styles including the gothic and baroque. Many tourists also may find the Astronomical Clock on this square and the tower at the Old Town Hall offers a panoramic view.

**Cathedral of St Vitus – This cathedral is an excellent example of Gothic architecture and is the biggest and most important church of the country.

**Overnight at Prague.

10 Prague (Czech Rep) – Nuremberg (Germany) – Frankfurt (BLD)

After breakfast, travel to **Nuremberg** for a brief orientation tour. Next, transfer to **Frankfurt**.

**Nuremberg – As a city "of wit", where inventiveness and the researchers' curiosity have found a home is a lively city of about half a million inhabitants, with a visible history of almost one thousand years.

**Overnight at Frankfurt

11 Frankfurt (Germany) – Transit City (B / MOB)

After Breakfast transfer to the airport for return flight back to Malaysia.

12 Transit City – Penang (MOB)

Arrive Penang, Home Sweet Home.

抵达后, 团队将前往萨尔茨堡市区游览于萨尔茨堡旧城。

今天, 出发前往克拉科夫, 途经班斯卡比斯特里察游览参观。

**班斯卡比斯特里察 - 于 1255 年为匈牙利的皇家城市, 是著名的冬夏旅游景点。

**夜宿于克拉科夫

7 克拉科夫 (早午晚餐)

前往探索 13 世纪的盐矿 - Wieliczka 盐矿, 圣 Kinga。接着返回克拉科夫市区游览, 包括, 克拉科夫老城区, 圣玛丽大教堂和圣福里安门。

**Wieliczka 盐矿 - 开采时间已有 900 年, 它曾经是世界上最和最古老的盐矿。

**圣福里安门 - 位于波兰克拉科夫, 是一座著名的波兰哥特式塔楼, 建于 14 世纪初, 使用红色花岗岩砌筑, 是克拉科夫

老城防御工事的一部分。

**夜宿于克拉科夫

8 克拉科夫 (波兰) - 布拉克 (捷克) (早午晚餐)

早餐后, 驱车前往布拉格 - 捷克首都。途径著名城市享用午餐。

**夜宿于布拉格

9 布拉克 (捷克) (早午晚餐)

早餐后, 前往参观布拉格城堡, 圣维特大教堂和圣老城广场。之后, 体验伏尔塔瓦游船。

**老城广场 - 游客们可以在广场上的许多教堂中, 发现老市政厅外墙上著名的天文钟, 而旧市政厅的塔楼则可供用来观看老城全景。包括哥特式和巴洛克式的各种建筑风格。
