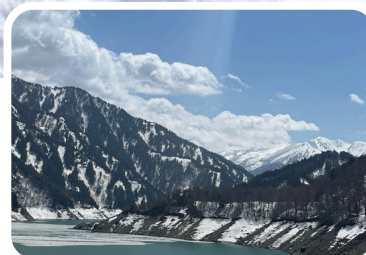
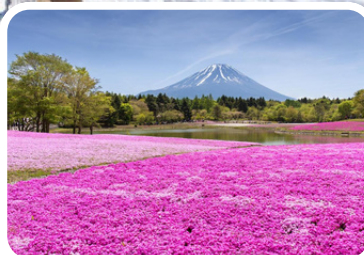

Nagoya / Takayama / Kanazawa / Tateyama / Tokyo



## D1 Penang - Transit

- Departure flight from Penang Int. Airport to Nagoya

## D2 Transit - Nagoya (LD)

- Nagoya Castle** - More than 2,000 cherry blossoms trees on pink smoke all building nestled among the touching scene
- Nabana No Sato** - A large flower garden resort
- Osu Shopping District**

## D3 Nagoya - Takayama (BLD)

- Gujo Hachiman** - Many historic buildings and original waterways from 17th century
- Takayama Festival Float Exhibition** - Ranked as one of Japan's three most beautiful festivals
- Takayama Jinya** - A beautiful traditional Japanese style building used to serve as Takayama's government office during Edo period

## D4 Takayama - Shirakawago - Kanazawa (BLD)

- Shirakawago** - In order to adapt to the environment here in the winter, and produced a "palms-made" style building
- Kenrokuen** - Japan's three most beautiful landscape garden
- Higashi Chaya** - Traditional neighborhood with teahouses where geisha perform

## D5 Kanazawa - Alpine Route - Matsumoto (BD)

- Alpine Route** - A spectacular tourist route, that across northern Japan, enjoy various transportation to travel, including cable cars, plateau buses, trolleybuses and overhead lifts

## D6 Matsumoto - Tokyo (BLD)

- Pink Moss Field** - Returning this spring with a staggering 500,000 pink, purple and white blooms
- Iyashino Sato Village** - Enjoy view of overlooking Mt Fuji

## D7 Tokyo - Transit (BLD)

- Asakusa Temple** - Designated as important cultural property of Japan
- Imperial Palace** (pass by) - Main residence of the Emperor of Japan
- Tokyo Tower**
- Rainbow Bridge Observation Deck**
- Statue of Liberty** - The French Statue of Liberty made in France in 1889 was placed in Odaiba from April 1998 to January 1999 as a symbol of the Japan-France friendship
- Ginza Shopping Area**
- Transfer to airport for departure flight home

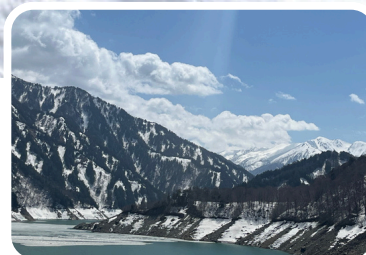
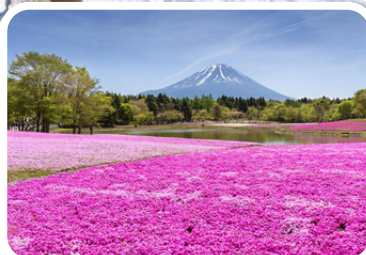

## D1 槟城 - 中转

- 槟城国际机场出发飞往名古屋

## D2 中转 - 名古屋 (午晚)

- 名古屋城 - 城堡的规模仍可一窥，加之其内的2000多株樱花树
- 名花之乡 - 一个大型花园度假村
- 大须商店街

## D3 名古屋 - 高山市 (早午晚)

- 郡上八幡 - 保留了传统城市的景观与许多历史建筑和原有的水路
- 高山祭屋台展示馆 - 被列为日本三大祭典之一
- 高山阵屋 - 一个美丽的日本传统建筑风格，作为直辖领地进行管理而设置的代官所、郡代投所

## D4 高山市 - 白川乡合掌村 - 金沢 (早午晚)

- 白川乡合掌村 - 为了适应此地冬天的环境，而产生了合掌造式的建筑
- 兼六园 - 三大最美的山水园林之一
- 东茶屋 - 美丽的出格子门窗和石板路面的街道景观

## D5 金沢 - 立山黑部阿尔卑斯山脉路线 - 松本 (早晚)

- 阿尔卑斯山脉路线 - 是穿越日本北方阿尔卑斯的一条壮观的旅游路线，可使用各种交通工具来旅行，包括缆车，高原巴士，无轨电车和架空索道

## D6 松本 - 东京 (早午晚)

- 紫樱公园 - 80万棵芝樱盛开绽放，形成一片壮丽的花毯覆盖大地
- Iyashino佐藤村 - 远眺富士山美景

## D7 东京 - 中转 (早午晚)

- 浅草寺 - 东京市历史最悠久的寺院
- 日本皇居(途径) - 日本天皇的宫殿，即天皇的办公及居住场所
- 东京铁塔 - 它的高度为333米，是日本第二高的建筑物
- 彩虹桥观景台 - 位于日本东京湾西北侧的双层吊桥及公路铁路两用桥
